(ANSA) - ROME, FEB 20 - The administration of the fourth (-31%) and fifth doses (-22.4%) of the anti-Covid vaccines has collapsed, according to the weekly independent monitoring of the Gimbe Foundation out Monday.

The report underlined that the national coverage rate for fourth doses is 31.1%.

There are sharp regional differences, Gimbe said.

These range from 14% in Calabria to 44.6% in Piedmont, said the foundation.

The national coverage rate for fifth doses is 14.8%.

Here, too, there are strong regional fluctuations, from 5% in Campania to 28% in Piedmont. (ANSA).
